INTERNATIONAL CREDIT MOBILITY

>Formerly established quality framework within Erasmus programme

Expected number of mobilities for 6 years period for WB - 135,000

➢ Budget for WB – 22.7 mEuro - 3600 mobilities foreseen (96% for students 7% for teaching staff)

- Estimation based on costs for one semester study
- Activities conducted by national agencies in respective countries





Students and staff mobility

>All levels of higher education (including also short cycle)

➢Open to all disciplines

>3 to 12 monts of study

>Up to 12 months per study cycle

Staff – from 5 days to 2 months



What does a mobility project imply?

 Project application submitted by HEI from the programme country to the national agency of the respective country defining the types and number of mobilities



Preconditions for mobility

- Erasmus charter
- Inter-institutional agreements defining number of mobilities and conditions, signed before the mobility takes place
- Learning Agreement for students
- Mobility Agreement for teaching staff



Erasmus charter: quality framework for cooperation activities

- No discrimination of any kind
- Full recognition of mobility periods
- No charging of tuition fees
- Publishing of courses catalogues
- Studens being well prepared for mobility (language, documents, logisticts)
- Visa assistance, accomodation, insurance
- Guidelines for icoming mobility
- Equal treatment and services
- Integration into the local society
- Mentoring work
- Linguistic support

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Learning agreement

- Signed by students, sending and receiving HEI
- Defining learing outcomes, recognition of mobility periods, rights and obligations of both parties



Mobility agreement

- Signed by teaching staff or administrative staff from HEIs
- Rights and obligations of both parties


- All HEIs from partner countries need to be officially accredited

Results of the first call within International Credit Mobility




1107 applications first round 593 contracts to HEIs











Advice to potential HEIs

Link to institutional strategies for internationalization
 Nomination of ECTS or Erasmus+ coordinators
 Catalogues of courses in English
 Redesign of faculty pages
 Insisting on reciprocal exchange agreements
 Build partnerships on already existing collaboration



Challenges/expectations

- More students` mobilities and mobilities of academic staff between EU and partner countries
- Reinforcement of mobilities for underrepresented university units
- Recognition once back to home universities
- Attract as many foreign students as possible
- Create study programmes in English
- Create network of coordinators per university units
- Participate in new partnership agreements with new HEIs
