








Budget requested under call 2016 (EUR million)




Ring-fenced budgets per NA




ICM 2017 Call budget

Estimated number of funded mobilities





Advice to Partner Country HEIs


- There are opportunities for cooperation with all 33 Programme Countries

- Work with your European partner on the application

- >Nomination of ECTS or Erasmus+ coordinators
- > Catalogues of courses in English
- > Redesign of faculty pages
- ➤ Build partnerships on already existing collaboration
