



# Horizontal aspects to be considered when designing your project:





## Eligibility

Who can apply?

• Any public or private organization, with its affiliated entity, active in the field of sport established in countries eligible for participation in this action Types of organizations (examples)

- A public body in charge for sport
- A sport organization
- N National Olympic Committee or National Sport Confederation
- An organization representing "sport for all" movement
- An organization active in the field of physical activity promotion
- An organization representing the active leisure sector

#### N° of organizations

- At least 4 organisations from minimum 3 countries
- 1 organisation from 2 different EU Member states and/or third countries associated to the Programme and
- at least 2 organisations from at least 1 eligible third country not associated to the Programme

### **Award criteria**

Relevance of the project (max 30)

Quality of the project design and implementation (max 20) Quality of partnership and the cooperation arrangements (max 20)

Impact (*max 30*)

<u>Note</u>: To be considered for funding, the proposal must score at least 60 points, at least half of the maximum score per each category.
