As from mid-2018, traineeships within a company are also possible, from 2 to 12 months


All levels: BA, MA, PhD, academic & administrative staff






Relised mobilities 2015-2018



## **How does ICM work?**

- HEI from programme country apply for mobility grant
- Duration of project: 24 or 36 months instead of 16 or 26
- Student mobility for studies and/or traineeship
- Staff mobility for teaching and/or training
- Deadline for application : February 5, 2019
- Apply to National Agency in programme country




Tripartite (if only SMP)



Quadripartite (if combined)


#### PARTNER COUNTRY TRAINEE



Quadripartite (always)




## **Advice to HEIs**

- There are opportunities for cooperation with all 34 Programme Countries
- Target envelopes with bigger budgets
- Newcomers, think about starting with staff mobility
- 36 month contracts recommended
- Be precise in the quality questions
- Get support from NEOs or EU Delegations
- Work with your European partner on the application

- Link to institutional strategies for internationalization
- Nomination of ECTS or Erasmus+ coordinators
- > Catalogues of courses in English
- Redesign of faculty pages
- > Build partnerships on already existing collaboration
