Applications may be from a HEI in any country of the world

Only one applicant institution is required

Apply directly to Executive Agency (EACEA)



Jean Monnet Call 2021: how to apply?

Applications must be submitted using the eForm with attachments Applicant organisation must be registered in Participant Portal and receive Participant Identification Code (PIC)

Create official electronic application form (eForm)

Fill in eForm

Attach completed versions of different attachments to the application/e-form

Relevance of the project

Quality of the project design and implementation

Quality of the project team

Impact and dissemination



How to make a competitive Jean Monnet proposal?

Before you start you should have:

Project concrete idea

Comprehensive knowledge about the Jean Monet action

Minimum number of partners



Application tips

Present all information in application.

Explain the working methodology and provide evidence of your expertise.

Describe project in a focused and structured way.

Support your statement with facts and figures.

Demonstrate that you will produce concrete and sustainable results.

Ask somebody who did not participate in the project preparation, to proofread it.



The proposal should answer the following questions:

Why is your proposal important? How will these activities happen?

By whom will it be implemented?

For whom is the proposal important? When will these activities happen?
